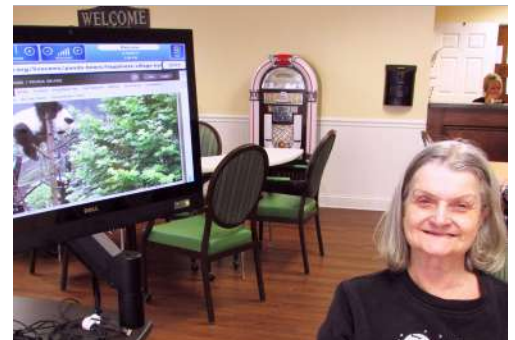
Caregivers Appreciation Sponsored by Pruitt Health

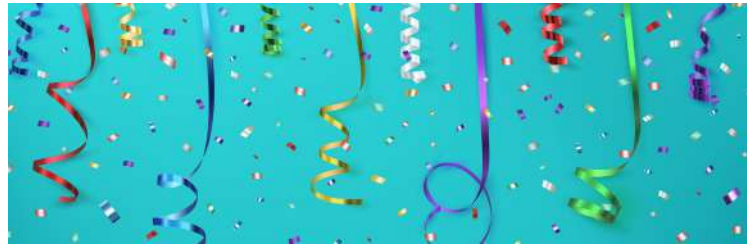
The Stepensions Duo

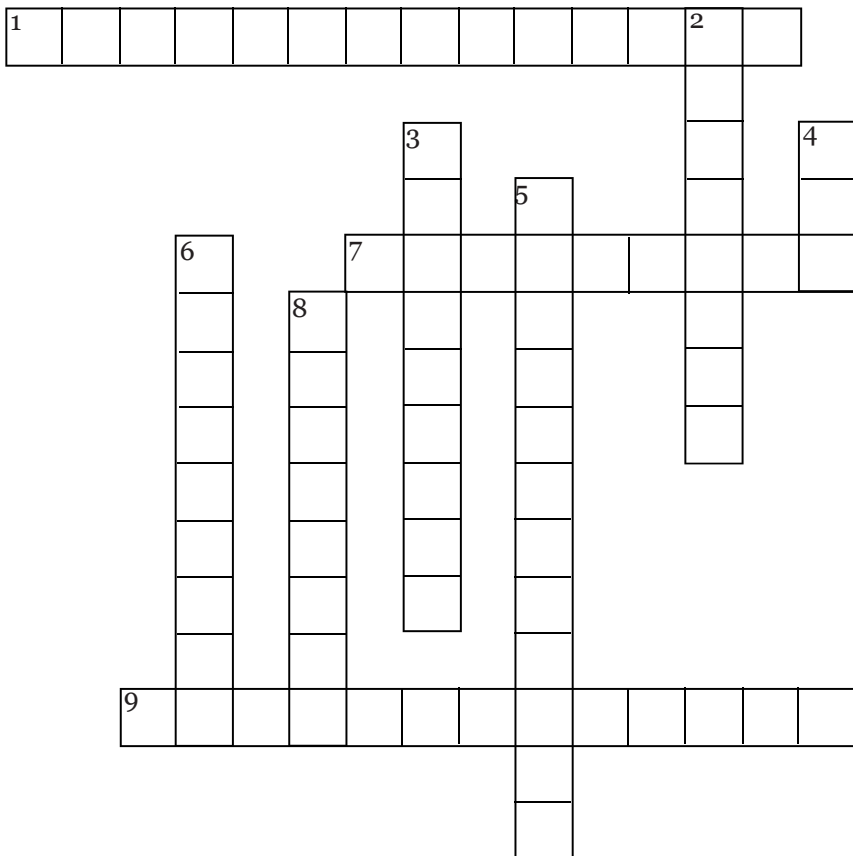

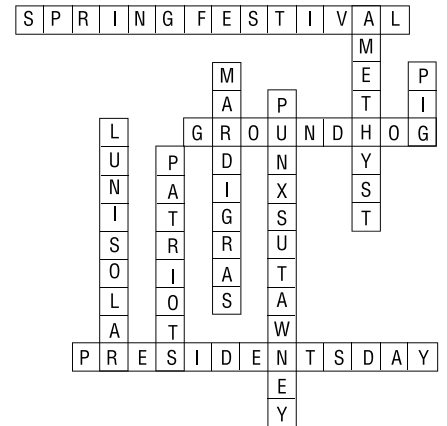
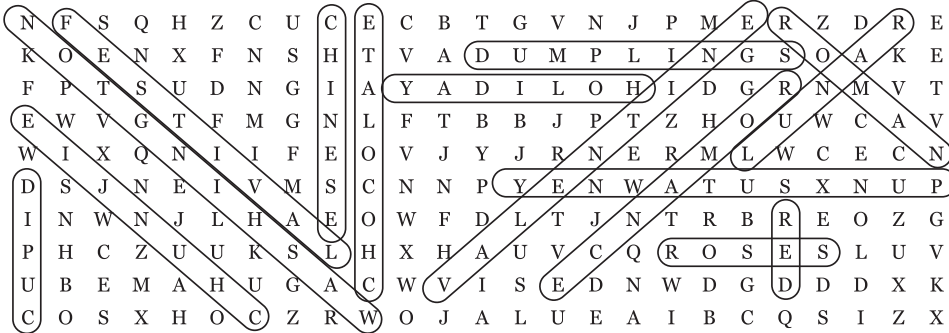
