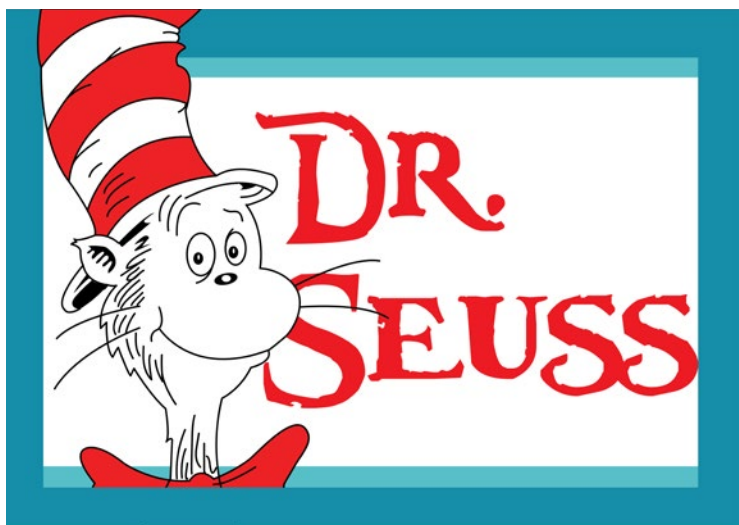
## BINGO

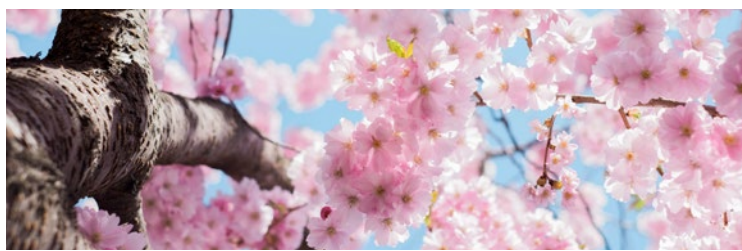


## St. Patrick's Day Celebration

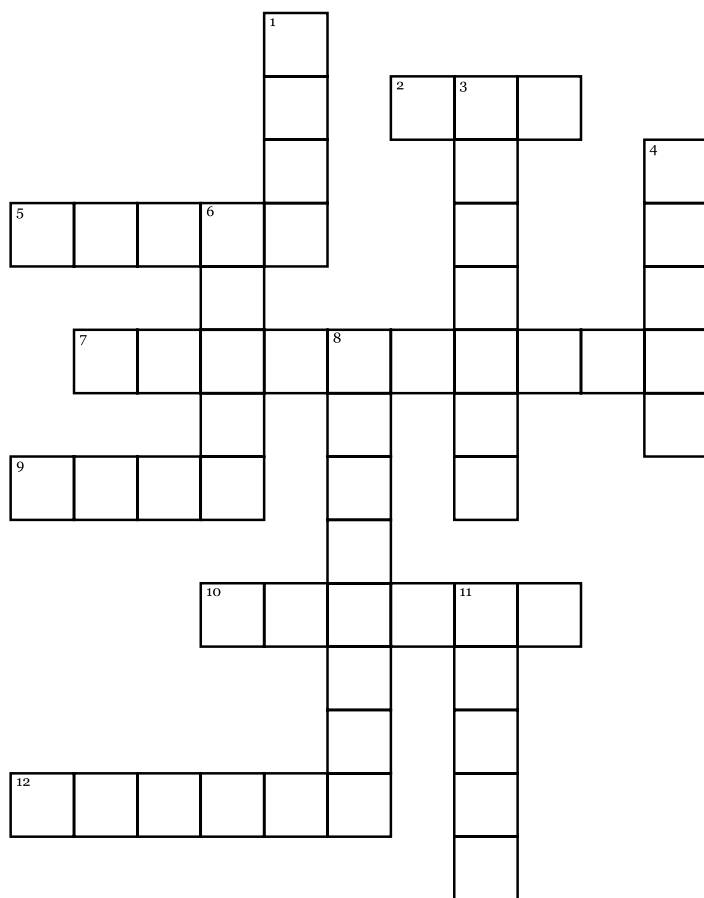

### Cindy Romines



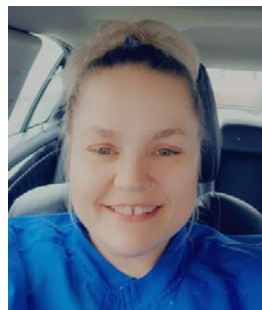

### Jennifer Westphal

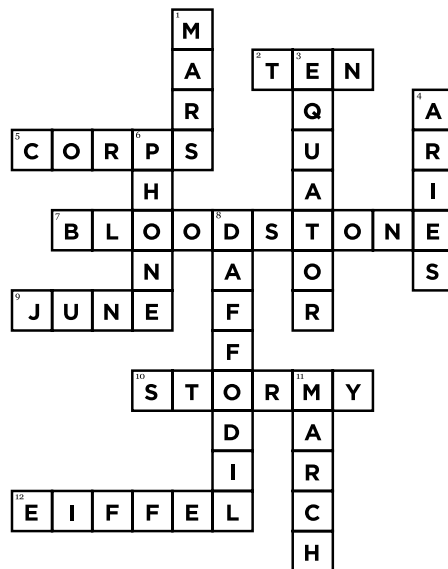
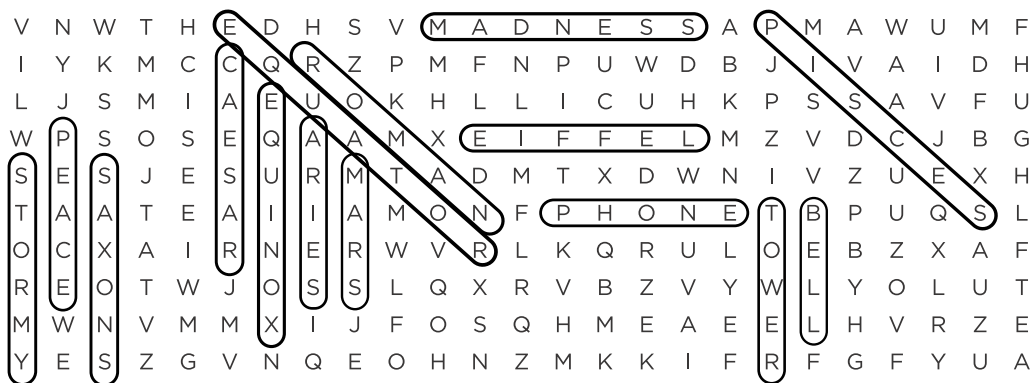
